



NOTICE

ASSEMBLY OF DODGE RAMBOX™ COVER TO TRUCK

STEP 1. Remove the end cap from the driver side cargo rail.




STEP 2. Assemble hardware as shown.





4.	1704246	Clamp Bracket Rambox


STEP 3. Slide three assembled brackets into each track of the driver and passenger side cargo rail.



STEP 4. Apply corner seal to front inside corner of box.




STEP 5. Starting from the front bulkhead of the Rambox™ place brackets at the dimensions shown and then tighten.




STEP 6. Fasten the rail to the brackets with the hardware shown.

NOTE: If your rail is tilting inward or sitting too high make sure your rail is sitting beside bolt head as shown and **NOT ON TOP.**

STEP 7.


Follow steps 1 through 6 to mount the driver side rail. After the side rails are attached insert the plastic cargo rail end caps. Refer to the owners manual for instructions on how to attach the cover assembly and for other operations of the truck bed cover.

ADDITIONAL SEALING AROUND TAILGATE

STEP 1. Apply seal 1118531 to bed caps as shown in the next two steps to help seal gap between bed cap and tailgate.






STEP 2. Once Lo Pro Rails are installed, clean the area shown below on Driver and Passenger side with wet rag.

Clean this area.



STEP 3. Apply Seal on Driver and Passenger Side as shown below.



Align seal flush along the top edge of the bed cap and the inner edge as shown.
