





INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

3. Fishwire the 7/16" bolts and SP2 spacers through the enlarged access hole and out the existing holes in the side of the frame rail, as shown. **Note:** Leave fishwires attached to prevent loss into the frame rails. Push the carriage bolts back into the frame rail prior to raising the hitch into position.





4. Raise hitch into position and pull the fishwires and carriage bolts through the side plates. **Note:** Feed the fishwires through the mouting holes while raising the hitch. Remove the fishwires from the carriage bolts and secure the hitch with 7/16" flange nuts.





5. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 70 ft-lbs.

Re-attach muffler brackets removed in Step 1.

Torque all M8 muffler bracket hardware to 23 ft-lbs.



INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Lower exhaust by removing (6) bolts from the muffler brackets, retain bolts for reinstallation.
- 2. Enlarge the access holes to allow the 7/16" carriage bolts and spacers to pass through.
- 3. Fishwire the 7/16" bolts and SP2 spacers through the enlarged access hole and out the existing holes in the side of the frame rail, as shown. **Note:** Leave fishwires attached to prevent loss into the frame rails. Push the carriage bolts back into the frame rail prior to raising the hitch into position.
- 4. Raise hitch into position and pull the fishwires and carriage bolts through the side plates. **Note:** Feed the fishwires through the mouting holes while raising the hitch.
- 5. Remove the fishwires from the carriage bolts and secure the hitch with 7/16" flange nuts.
- 6. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 70 ft-lbs.
- 7. Re-attach muffler brackets removed in Step 1. Torque all M8 muffler bracket hardware to 23 ft-lbs.
