Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BACKREST COVER - 60 PORTION: A)

1) Remove head rest (see note)

- 2) Slip cover over backrest. Ensure cover is installed under seat belt
- Holding cushion up in 34 position allows for better access

3) Pass straps behind the seat straight down

4) Smooth cover tightly from top to bottom

5) Install adhesive back velcro (included) on inside edge of armrest well to align with velcro on seat cover. NOTE: BEFORE SECURING

VELČRO, CLEAN AREA WITH ALCOHOL SWAB PROVIDED.

6) Hold cushion up in ³/₄ position, tuck bottom of cover through crevice under backrest 7) With cushion up, locate straps and secure to buckles on seat

cover 8) Locate bottom right flap through crevice and hold at back of seat. With other hand bring the side flap around and attach (see note) 9) Repeat on left side

10) Adjust all straps, buckles and velcro

B) **BACKREST COVER - 40 PORTION:**

1) Repeat steps 1 – 4 from A) above

C) CUSHION COVER - 60 PORTION AND 40 PORTION:

1) Center cover on the seat

2) Tuck back flap through crevice

3) Lift seat and pass straps under seat and buckle

4) Pass side straps and buckle

2) Repeat steps 6 - 10 from A) above

5) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension

D) ARMREST COVER

1) Fold down armrest

2) Slip cover over armrest and attach velcro

NOTES:

1) SELF-LOCKING SUPER-GRIP® BUCKLE:



2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:

A) - Insert paper clip into holes at base to release - Lift off

- OR B) - Push in side release buttons
- Lift off
- (If unable to remove consult dealership)

3) Material can be tucked in between cup holder and armrest for a better look.

3) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS

A) Ensure pre-cut holes in seat cover align with holes in headrest base.

B) Replace headrests

4) HEADREST COVERS

Some models may contain more than one set of headrest covers. Select the ones that fit your headrests best.

5) BACKREST COVER BOTTOM FLAP INSTALLATION
