




INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the 3 factory push pins from the inner fender well on holes #1 to #3.
- 3. Gently pull the liner away to install spring nuts (i) on recessed factory tabs, which previously contained the factory push pins.





- 4. Loosely install mud flap holes #4 & #5 to factory holes #1 & #2 through spring nuts (i) using a stainless steel bolt (f) and flat washer (b)
- 5. Loosely install mud flap hole #6 to factory hole #3 through spring nut (i) using a stainless steel bolt (f) and an offset washer (d)
- 6. Using a square or bubble level, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten all fasteners.
- 7. Drill a ¼" hole through mud flap hole #7 into liner to create hole #8.
- 8. Install mud flap hole #7 through liner hole #8 using a machine screw (e) and flat washer (a) and secure with a flat washer (c), lock washer (g), and hex nut (h)
- 9. Ensure that the mud flap has remained square. Tighten all fasteners.
- 10. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.





INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 2. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the 4 factory push pins from the inner fender well on holes #1 to #4, and factory bolt from underside of fender.
- 3. Gently pull the liner away to install spring nuts (i) on recessed factory tabs, which previously contained the factory push pins.



- 4. Slide the brace through mud flap slot #9 and fasten through brace hole #12 and mud flap hole #10 using a machine screw (e) and flat washer (c). Secure with a flat washer (c), lock washer (g), and hex nut (h).
- 5. Loosely install mud flap holes #5 & #6 to factory holes #1 & #2 through spring nuts (i) using a stainless steel bolt (f) and flat washer (b)
- 6. Loosely install mud flap holes #7 & #8 to factory holes #3 through a flat washer spacer (d) and spring nut (i) using a stainless steel bolt (f) and a flat washer (a)
- 7. Using a square or bubble level, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten all fasteners.
- 8. Reinstall factory bolt on underside of fender through the brace hole #11.
- 9. Ensure that the mud flap has remained square. Tighten all fasteners.
- 10. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
