

99-01 FORD SUPER DUTY DUALLY <u>REAR</u> MUD GUARD INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read instructions thoroughly before installation.

Tools Required


- Short Phillips screwdriver
- Cutting tool for removal of existing plastic fasteners

Package Contents

- Driver & passenger side rear mud guard
- #10 screw (qty. 10)
- Fender washer (qty. 10)
- U-clip (qty. 10)
- Instruction sheet

NOTE: It may be necessary to remove the wheels depending on the tools being used for installation.

- 1. Clean and degrease the mud guard location area on the fender before installation.
- 2. Remove existing plastic fasteners from locations A, C, D, and E by cutting off the heads of the fasteners and pushing the remaining piece through the fender tab hole (Figure 1).
- 3. Remove the existing screw and washer from location B with a short phillips screwdriver.
- 4. Pull back fender liner to expose fender tabs (Figure 1 and 3).
- 5. Install a U-clip at locations A, B, C, D, and E (Figure 2 and 3)
- 6. Place mud guard between fender and fender liner and install a #10 screw and washer through fender liner, mud guard, U-clip and fender tab at locations A, B, C, D, and E (Figure 1 and 2), check fit and alignment before tightening.



PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Clean mud guard with a soap and water solution to remove dirt and other contaminates.
- 2. Sand painting surface with 320 grit sand paper.
- 3. Apply a coating of flexible primer-adhesion promoter.
- 4. Apply a flexible paint as directed by the paint
