#### **PROCEDURE**


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
  Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. For vehicles without factory tow hooks: Trim the plastic in the areas as shown in Figures 1 & 2. Repeat for the passenger side. Note: If you have a 2018-2020 vehicle, the tow hook covers may be removable. See Step 6 to remove the tow hook covers then proceed with Step 3.







- 3. **For vehicles** with factory tow hooks: Remove tow hooks and loosely install the Lower Mounting Brackets (Items 4 & 5) to the factory nut plates using supplied M12 hardware as shown in **Figure 4.** Note: Trimming of screws may be required if they interfere with lower mounting bracket. See **Figure 5** for reference.
- 4. **For vehicles without tow hooks:** Slip the M12 Double Nut Plates (Item 9) into frame and line up with existing holes. See **Figure 3** for reference. Loosely install the Lower Mounting Brackets (Items 4 & 5) using the supplied M12 hardware as shown in **Figure 4**. *Note: Trimming of screws may be required if they interfere with lower mounting bracket. See Figure 5 for reference.*
- 5. For 2015-2017 Models Only: Remove all factory hardware and clips attached to grille, then remove grille. See Figures 6 through 12 for reference.




























- 6. For <u>2018-2020 Models</u> Only: Remove plastic covers that are located above the location of the tow hooks to expose (3) nuts on each side. Then, remove the nuts in order to remove the front bumper. See **Figures 13 & 14** for reference.
- 7. For <u>all</u> vehicle models: Remove factory bumper bolt as shown in Figure 15. Install the Upper Mounting Bracket (Item 6 & 7) using the supplied M8 hardware. Make sure the brackets are approximately 39-3/4" apart from outer bracket flange. For the 2018-2020 models, make sure to lay the bracket firmly on top of the rubber strip that is on top of the bumper. Tighten M8 hardware to 15 ft-lbs. See Figures 16 through 18. Note: Figure 16 for 2015-2017 models and Figure 17 for 2018-2020 models.
- 8. Reinstall grille, headlight covers, and any other parts removed in the reverse order of the install instructions.


















- 9. With assistance hold the Grille Guard Base up to the previously installed brackets. Loosely attach the Grille Guard Base to the brackets using the supplied M12 hardware for the lower mounting brackets only. See **Figures 19 & 20.**
- 10. Locate and mount the HDX Driver Wing (Item 2) to the Grille Guard Base using the supplied M8 Hardware (Items 19-21). Note: For the mounting hole shared with the upper Support Straps, the M12 Hardware will be used. See Figure 21 & 22 for reference.
- 11. Repeat for the HDX Passenger Wing (Item 3).
- 12. Align and adjust the Grille Guard Base and the Wings as necessary. Tighten and torque the M8 hardware to 16-18 ft-lbs. and the M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.











13. For models with front cameras, remove the screen in the Grille Guard as shown in Figure 23.


