

PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on either side of the vehicle, use a flathead screwdriver to remove the plastic covers located around the factory tow hooks. Repeat for the opposite side. <u>Note:</u> Plastic around tow hook must be trimmed in order for bracket to fit through. See *Figures 1 & 2* for reference.







- 3. Underneath the front of the vehicle locate factory bracket that is attached on the frame and remove the factory hardware. See **Figure 3** for reference. *Note:* Factory hardware will not be re-used.
- 4. Re-use the factory hardware from under the plastic cover. See **Figure 4** for reference. *Note:* Factory nut plates will not be re-used.







- 5. Remove the OEM bumper by removing (4) bolts on both sides of the vehicle near the front tires and make sure to disconnect any electrical wires. See **Figures 5 and 6** for reference.
- 6. Remove the factory tow hooks as shown in Figure 7. Note: Factory tow hooks will not be re-used.










7. Starting on either side of the vehicle. Locate (1) Lower Mounting Bracket (Items 2-3) and from the front of the vehicle, install it at the tow hook mounting locations. Align the bracket with the vehicle frame in the same location that the factory bracket was previously located. Loosely mount the bracket using the provided M12 hardware (Items 6-9). See **Figures 8** and 9 for reference.






8. Locate (1) Bumper Bracket (Items 4-5) and loosely secure it onto vehicle frame and Lower Mounting Bracket using the provided M10 and M12 hardware (Items 7-12), See **Figures 10 and 11** for reference.






- 9. Locate (1) Lower Support Bracket (Item 20) and insert through the newly trimmed slots and loosely secure it onto vehicle frame using the factory hardware. See **Figure 12** for reference.
- 10. Repeat Steps 7-9 for other side.
- 11. As mentioned previously, trimming of the lower valence will be needed in order to slide the lower bracket through.




- 12. Re-install the front bumper in reverse order that it was previously removed. Re-install the plastic cover where the factory tow hooks were located.
- 13. Locate (1) Winch Tray (Item 1) and loosely secure it onto the Lower Mounting Brackets using the supplied M12 hardware (Items 13-16). See **Figure 13** for reference.
- 14. Locate (1) HDX Grille Guard Base (Item 17) and with assistance align it with the previously installed brackets and loosely secure using the supplied M12 hardware. See **Figure 14 & 15** for reference.
- 15. Locate and mount the HDX Driver Wing (Item 18) to the Grille Guard Base using the supplied M8 Hardware (Items 19-21). <u>Note</u>: For the mounting hole shared with the upper Support Straps, the M12 Hardware will be used. See **Figures 14 & 16** for reference.
- 16. Repeat for the HDX Passenger Wing (Item 17).


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
17. Align and adjust the Grille Guard Base, Wings, Winch Tray, and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque the M8 hardware to 16-18 ft-lbs, M10 hardware to 30-25 ft-lbs, and the M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.




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








CARE INSTRUCTIONS
