

## **Universal Installation Instructions**

## **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- Corded or Cordless Drill
- 3/8" Socket Driver
- 1/4" Drill Bit (Optional)

## **KIT CONTAINS:**

- 8 Self-Tapping 1/4"x1" Screws
- 8 Flat Washers
- Full or Cut Style Mud Flaps

IMPORTANT: The manufacturer is not responsible for negligent use of vehicle with mud flaps installed, including over-tightening of screws or bolts causing damage to vehicle or mud flaps

## **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Before you install your mud flaps, see the parts list for necessary parts
- 2. Square the flap with the tire while putting pressure against the wheel well, the outside edge of the flap should be 1/2" past the wheel well
- 3. Fasten the mud flaps into the metal lip of the wheel well with four washers and self-tapping screws. (Tip: Start with the top screw, this will allow you to level the flap before installing the other screws. You may also use a drill bit to make a pilot hole)
- 4. Repeat the procedure for remaining mud flaps

\*Removing wheel may be necessary for installation
