



## **INSTALLATION** (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the factory screw from the inner wheel well.
- 3. Install 2 clips included with kit into the holes #1 & #2 located at the upper part of the mud flap. When installing these clips, ensure that the lower part of the clip is placed into the lower cutout.

- 4. Loosely secure the clip on hole #1 using a small flat washer (#018018) and a hex bolt (#016041), and the clip on hole #2 using a large flat washer (#018066) and a hex bolt (#016041).
- 5. Install mud flap through hole #3 to fender hole #5 using a large flat washer (#018066) and a hex bolt (#016041).
- Ensure that the inner most part of the flap is tucked behind the liner as shown in Diagram B.
- Cut liner to allow flap to sit flush against the back of the liner as shown in Diagram C.
- Insert clips on holes #1 and #2 into the fender lip and tighten the screws to secure the clips.
- 9. Using a bubble level or square, ensure that the mud flap is level. Viewing the vehicle from the back, the outer edge of the mud flap should appear parallel to the tires.
- 10. Drill a '4" hole through mud flap and fender liner to create hole #4 and hole #6.
- 11. Install one machine screw (012022), and one flat washer (#018081) through hole #4 into hole #6 and secure with one flat washer (018031), one lock washer (024001) and one hex nut (025003).
- 12. Carefully tighten all fasteners and ensure that the flap has remained level.
- 13. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.



**f)** (2) Washer, Lock 18-8SS, Helicoil Part #024001



## INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 2. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the 2 factory screw from the inner wheel well on holes #4 & #5.
- 3. Position the flap so that the inner most part of the mud flap sits behind the liner as shown in Diagram B.
- 4. Mark the liner on either side of the mud flap.





- 5. Set the flap aside and cut the liner on the marks as shown in Diagram C.
- 6. Ensure that the inner most part of the flap is tucked behind the liner as shown in Diagram B.
- 7. Loosely install mud flap through holes #1 & #2 into factory holes #4 & #5 and secure with a hex bolt (016041) and a 1-1/2" flat washer (018066)
- 8. With a square of other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level.
- 9. Tighten all fasteners.
- 10. Drill a 1/4" hole through mud flap and fender liner to create hole #3 and hole #6.
- 11. Install one machine screw (012022), and one flat washer (#018081) through hole #3 into hole #6 and secure with one flat washer (018031), one lock washer (024001) and one hex nut (025003).
- 12. Carefully tighten all fasteners and ensure that the flap has remained level.
- 13. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
