

DURING AND/OR AFTER INSTALLATION: Ensure emergency brake cables are not touching the SuperSprings. Secure any cables out of the way with zip ties or by re-routing. **Ensure all A/C lines, brake cables and frame are clear of contact or interference.**



- **1.** Park vehicle of level hard surface. Engage emergency brake. Place blocks in front and behind front wheels to prevent rolling. Observe all safety precautions and wear safety glasses.
- 2. Starting on the driver's side, locate the brake line bracket on the inside of the frame above the axle. [photo 1]
- **3.** Remove the bolt holding the bracket to the frame. [photo 2]
- **4.** Add the included spacer ensuring the locating pin is located in the hole in the frame and the tab of the bracket locates in the spacer. [photo 3]
- **5.** Add a drop of blue loctite to the threads of the M8x50mm bolt and install it through the bracket and spacer and thread into the frame. Torque to 15 ft. lbs. [photo 4]
- **6.** With the vehicle still on the ground (ONE SIDE AT A TIME), loosen axle U-bolts to allow removal of the factory bump-stop. [photos 5 & 6]
- **7.** Apply Loctite to threads of the stud on mounting bracket and install the SumoSprings by turning it tightly on to the stud.
- **8.** Raise the rear of the vehicle to provide sufficient room to install the SumoSprings and support with jack stands.
- **9.** Install the SumoSprings mounting bracket under the U-bolts. [photo 7]
- **10.** Tighten the U-bolt nuts until snug.
- **11.** Remove jack stands and lower the truck.
- **12.** Re-tighten the U-bolts using factory specifications and procedure.
- **13.** Repeat procedure on the other side.


