


Manufacturer is not responsible for negligent use of vehicle with mud flaps installed, including over-tightening of screws and bolts causing damage to vehicle or mud flaps.





INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)


- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts.
- 2. Remove the (1) factory screw on the underside of the flare (Diagram "A" hole #1) and set aside to reinstall later.
- 3. Remove the (1) factory push pin on the upper portion of the flare (Diagram "A" hole #2) and set aside to reinstall later.
- 4. Gently pull flare out and install bracket between flare and inner liner. *Note: Bracket will require slight bend to properly fit*
- 5. Realign and re-install screw in bottom of flare (Diagram "A" hole #1), and push pin on upper portion of flare Diagram "A" (hole #2).
- 6. Install square brace on the tire retention impact bar, as shown in Diagram "B".







- 7. Align the slots in the mudflap with the riv nuts in the brackets, as shown in Diagram "C"
- 8. Install first the nylon washer, then a black stainless washer and a black ¹/₄" stainless steel bolt through holes marked as #1 as shown in Diagram "C"
- 9. Slide square brace into place as shown in Diagram "C", number 2, and install through hole #3 with a stainless washer, and ¹/₄" stainless steel bolt. Secure from behind using a stainless steel washer, lock washer, and hex nut.
- 10. Before tightening, check that the flap is straight and level using a square of bubble level. (Do not over tighten)
- 11. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
