






INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)


- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts.
- 2. Remove the (1) factory push pin from hole number #1 on Diagram "A" and discard.
- 3. Remove the (1) factory screw from hole #2 on Diagram "A" and set aside to reinstall later.
- 4. Gently pull flare out and install bracket between flare and inner liner, aligning hole #1 with hole #3 and hole #2 with hole #4. *Note: Bracket will require slight bend to properly fit*
- 5. Re-install screw in bottom of flare (Diagram "A" hole #2 and #4)







- 6. Install supplied bolt, washers, lock washer, and nut through holes #1 and #3 as shown in Diagram "B"
- 7. Align slots #5 to #7 with the dimples in the bracket and fasten using supplied U-Clamps, nylon washer, stainless washer, and screw as shown in Diagram "B"
- 8. Before tightening, ensure that the flap is level using a square of bubble level. Do not over tighten.
- 9. Using hole #8 on the mud flap and hole #9 on the bracket as a guide, drill a ½" hole through the inner fender liner.
- 10. Fasten the mud flap hole #8 to the liner through hole #9 using a 1/4" bolt, stainless steel washer, lock washer, and nut.
- 11. Tighten all fasteners
- 12. Repeat on passenger side.
